AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR ENGINEERING DESIGN SERVICES FOR A NEW FUEL FARM SYSTEM FOR BOTH JET A, AND 100LL WITH ABOVEGROUND TANKS.

Re: Airport Fuel Farm

Executive Summary

West Plains Regional Airport is seeking approval of this ordinance to complete engineering design for a new fuel farm system for both Jet A, and 100LL with aboveground tanks.

Discussion

Through this process we have been working on for around a year now, Jviation (our airport consultant) have taken the lead in this for planning the project to submitting to the state for use of our annual entitlement airport funds. The current fuel farm has been in operation since the mid-80s. Life expectancy for underground tanks are 30 years, and we have had a lot of trouble out of the pumps which are both obsolete for new parts and hard to repair when issues occur. We currently offer Jet-A and 100LL for sale, the Jet-A pump was installed at the time of the airport build and the 100LL pump was moved from the old downtown airport which we've been told is from the 60s.

The current project will only be for engineering design this year, with plans to do the final project after receiving our next yearly appropriation of \$159,000.00.

The information below shows the funds that are available for our project. The 2018 funds have to be spent this fiscal year.

Fiscal Impact

We budgeted \$70,000.00 this year for our match to a complete project which would cover our 10% \$12,866.00 of the design cost which is \$128,660.70. The remainder is part of our yearly entitlement block grant funds for airport improvements.
