The Street Department for the City of West Plains is seeking bids for Asphalt Striping on select city streets. The City reserves the right to waive any informalities or minor defects or to reject any or all bids and to re-advertise and to rebid.

Each Bidder must deposit with his bid, security in the amount of five percent (5%) of his base bid.

## PREVAILING HOURLY WAGE RATES

Attention of Bidder is particularly called to the requirements as conditions of employment to be observed and that BIDDER must comply with the payment of hourly wage rates, including all fringe benefits, as established by the Wage Determination Sections 290.262. RSMo 2000 Wage Order No. 30 pertaining to the prevailing hourly rate of wages and including fringe benefits, as established by the Department of Labor

and Industrial Relations of the State of Missouri. A copy of each Determination will be provided prior to the bidding date.

Bidder shall furnish an affidavit and documentation affirming their company is enrolled in and participates in E-verify/Basic Pilot and an affidavit stating the business does not knowingly employ illegal aliens.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within Thirty (30) consecutive calendar days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

Bidder is advised to visit the sites and develop, to his satisfaction, the scope of improvements, and the intent of the drawings and specifications.
