THIS PERMIT IS SUBJECT TO ALL APPLICABLE CITY CODES AND ORDINANCES.

- (A) No individual or organization may discharge fireworks as herein defined, without a permit.
- (B) The discharge of display fireworks will need to be approved by the city council . This approval will need to be completed at the council meeting held before the display date.
- (C) All state and local applications, permits, and inspections must be completed as well. Indoor pyrotechnics displays are prohibited in establishments which are licensed to serve alcohol within the city. A special use permit would be required through the state division of fire safety and the city fire and rescue for any other pyrotechnic displays within the city limits.
- (D) Unless a permit has been approved by the fire chief or his designee, the use of sky lanterns is prohibited in the city. They are constructed from oiled rice paper on a bamboo frame and contain a small candle or fuel cell composed of a waxy flammable material. When lit, the flame heats the air inside the lantern, causing the lantern to rise into the air. The sky lantern is only airborne for as long as the flame stays alight, after which the lantern floats back to the ground.
