Transit Rules

- 1. All fares must be paid upon boarding the bus.
- Eating, drinking, smoking, chewing tobacco, possessing open containers, and soliciting of any kind are strictly prohibited on all transit vehicles.
- Fighting, physical or verbal abuse, and the use of profane language will not be tolerated. Any rider who poses a threat to the driver or fellow passengers may be denied boarding or asked to exit the vehicle.
- 4. Any behavior that distracts the driver, shows disrespect, or causes offense to others on board is not permitted.
- All passengers must wear seat belts while the vehicle is in motion.
- Passengers are expected to maintain good personal hygiene and must be appropriately dressed at all times, including wearing shoes and shirts.
- All carry on items must be secured and are limited to what the passenger can hold on to at his or her seat.
- Service animals are welcome on all vehicles. However, animals
 that pose a threat to the driver or other passengers must be
 properly restrained or confined.
- Necessary medical equipment, such as oxygen tanks, is permitted on all vehicles. Equipment must be properly secured to prevent injury in the event of a sudden stop or accident.
- 10. Drivers are trained to handle emergency situations. Passengers are required to follow all instructions provided by the driver to ensure safety.
- 11. If a passenger violates a rule, the driver will reference the applicable policy and request compliance. Continued violations may result in suspension or denial of service.

The City of West Plains receives funding under the Federal Transit Administration, Section 5311 non-urban public transportation program and complies with all state, federal, and local regulations.


